Lorenzo Mosca is full professor of Sociology of Culture and Communication at the Department of Economics and Management, Parma University. Among his research interests lie sociology of digital media and political communication, sociology of participatory processes, civil society, political parties and social movements, populism. His scientific production consists of more than 100 publications, including 7 monographs, 8 edited books/special issues, 51 book chapters and 42 journal articles.
